New Head for Youlgrave

All Saints has welcomed a new Head Teacher, Fiona Jackson, who began at the primary school last month.

She says she is thrilled to take up the post and is delighted to come to Youlgrave. "I was attracted to the school," she says, "because I understand village life and working together as a community. It's a lovely school, the children are very

friendly and I've received an openarmed welcome from everyone."

Fiona says she wants to maintain and build upon the impressive level of achievement at All Saints. At the end of last year, Youlgrave School came joint top of Derbyshire's 238 primary schools listed in national tables, based on aggregate performances at Key Stage two.

Teaching is an important part of the

job for Fiona, and she has already rearranged the timetables so she teaches at every level of the school and gets to know all the pupils. "I try and be visible and approachable," she says. "I intend to listen to the parents and develop a partnership with them and other community groups in Youlgrave, including the Church."

Frederick W. Shimwell (1923 – 2007)

Fred Shimwell, who died in December aged 84, was a natural painter whose artistic talent was, to Youlgrave's great combined benefit. with a dedication to welldressing. For more than half the century, his last leadership and dramatic designs for Bank Top served as an example and an encouragement to the elite aroup designers who created the village's

outstanding reputation. His artistry was innate and untutored: having left Youlgrave school at 14, he spent almost all his career in the engineering section of the Long Rake Spar Company.

He was a good companion, a friendly and generous man, always ready with a lively, warm greeting to the end. His life was guided by loyalty and a strong spirit of service. He helped the village in many voluntary ways, including the lighting and scenery for the pantomime and stage productions; and he sat as a parish councillor and helped to promote sport and recreation. When war brought the call to serve his country, he joined the Royal Corps of Signals as a despatch rider, bringing home five campaign medals awarded for service on the



Home Front and in North Africa and Italy.

Fred's lifelong love was ballroom dancing, and it was this pastime that brought him the more romantic version of lifelong love. He met Dorothy at Bakewell's weekly dance and, smitten, wasted no time in converting his chosen partner on the dance floor to his partner for life. They were married in 1948.

There is an enduring memory of Fred and Dot dancing for England in the German spa town of Erbach-im-Odenwald. They, with seven other Youlgrave dressers, had come to introduce the Derbyshire style of dressing wells to this small town celebrated nationally for its annual festival.

In the evening, after the ceremonies at which the screens had been a sensation, the Festhalle was packed with the hosts and visitors who, in beer garden fashion, offered spontaneous turns to the spirit of enjoyment - all except the Englischers, of course, who hid behind their national reticence and fear of showing off. To Fred, letting the side down was more a more reprehensible offence, so he took Dot onto the dance floor and, while the revellers stood back in admiration, they gave a virtuoso exhibition of the slow foxtrot. Honour was restored and, when the welldressers departed next day, they left with a reputation for having more to their CV than skill with petals.

Seven years later, Fred took Dot to live in Buxton, but he left his heart behind in Youlgrave. Though Dot died in 2006, Fred is survived by sons Ronald and Phillip and their children and grandchildren, all of who have been instilled with his sense of values.

Fred was an apostle of welldressing in the long tradition of Youlgrave designers who have gone out to innovate and assist in other towns and villages. Taking the custom to Germany may have been his biggest challenge, but Chesterfield, Buxton, Pleasley, Hartington and Middleton have reason, too, to remember him with gratitude for his unstinting dedication to the ephemeral art. Unless welldressing already exists in Heaven, it must surely now be only a matter of time before it does.

Fiona was born and brought up in Hathersage and went to Hope Valley College, then Lady Manners Sixth Form. After gaining a degree in education from Manchester University she taught in Timperley and Buxton. She lives in Tideswell with her husband and 9-vear-old son and says that her hobbies include DIY and house renovation - they're currently doing up their third house! "I also try and find time to play the piano and, like many parents, seem to be my son's regular taxi driver," she says. But Fiona doesn't complain, of course, and you get the sense that she thrives on activity, hard work and enthusiasm. The outlook for Youlgrave School would seem to be very rosy.





In the Spring, a final draft plan will be available for your perusal and approval. Then the work will really begin!



FURTHER DIGITAL TV OPTIONS FOR YOULGRAVE

We won't have to wait until 2011 for accessible digital TV, says Peter Rhodes

Following the article in the last issue of the Bugle regarding Digital Television, I would like to draw readers attention to a new satellite service which will be totally separate to BSKYB. This is very important to residents of Youlgrave, because Freeview will not be available until 2011, whereas this service will offer better content on both standard and high definition TV's – and much sooner.

Normally if you think of satellite TV, then you think of BSKYB or SKY services. These range from Pay TV services of every flavour to the SKY Freesat service which was referred to in the article. Even if you opt for the SKY Freesat service, you will still need to pay a single charge to BSKYB for the set top box and installation and an additional charge for the viewing card.

However, the BBC and ITV have co-operated and will launch a new satellite service in Spring of this year which, somewhat confusingly, will be called FREESAT. However this is nothing to do with BSKYB (in fact, it will compete) and will also allow viewers to watch free High Definition (HD) TV at no extra cost. Just a one-off payment will be needed for the digital set-top box, satellite dish and installation – so you pay once and watch forever. Prices for the various set top boxes have yet to be announced.

I believe that the main retailers, such as Currys, Dixons, Comet, etc, will be initially stocking the boxes and offering installation services. And if you currently have a satellite dish to receive services such as BBC Three and ITV2 on BSKYB Freesat, your existing dish is probably suitable for receiving this new Freesat service.

Freesat will bring you over 80 channels of top entertainment. Including films, music, news and children's TV. The full channel line-up will be announced nearer Freesat's launch date.

The BBC will offer a wide range of red button (interactive) services on Freesat. From launch, you'll be able to

read the latest news and sport stories 24 hours a day, check out what's happening in the world of business, enjoy entertainment news, etc.

From Summer of 2008, you will be able to get a wide range of news in video at any time you want it, with local weather information. During the Beijing Olympics, you'll be able to choose


between coverage of different sports and highlights to get the whole BBC Olympics package.

This will be an important public introduction of HDTV. If you haven't yet got an HD-ready television, you can still be prepared for the future by getting a Freesat HD digital box. With a Freesat HD digital box, you can still view HD programmes on your standard definition television, but the content will be scaled down to standard definition. If you buy a Freesat standard definition box you will not be able to view HD programmes even if you have an HD-ready television.

CAR SHARING – IS ANYONE INTERESTED?

It is one of the recommendations in the Village Plan and an ambition of Sustainable Youlgrave that we should seek to develop car sharing arrangements in the village.

I am giving some time to this and among the issues we have to face are:

- Who owns the shared vehicle?
- How is its purchase financed?
- · What sort of vehicle is it?
- Where is it kept?

In the simplest kind of arrangement, the shared vehicle would be owned jointly by the people who share it. They would decide what kind of vehicle to buy, where to keep it and the arrangements for sharing its cost and its use.

If anyone in the village is interested in jointly owning and sharing a vehicle I would like to hear from them with their own preferred answers to the four questions above. The vehicle might be one that a proposed sharer already owns or be bought (new or second-hand) for the purposes of sharing. And it might be a small van rather than a car. It depends what you need.

Sustainable Youlgrave explores the possibilities of community owned 'Green Energy'

Sustainable Youlgrave recently met John Malone, a consultant who works for E4All ('Energy4All'). He explained that they are working for the East Midlands Development Agency (emda), which is inviting applications for a development grant designed to help community groups such as Sustainable Youlgrave. It's called Community Owned Green Energy. It's all very new - a pilot programme in which emda. E4All and the communities learn from each other. The initial programme fund is £160k, for eight ventures across the East Midlands region.

On first impressions, it looks as though this might be timely for the energy strand of Sustainable Youlgrave's three-pronged road map.

However, as John Malone said, our project is more marginal and more complex, and some elements are smaller in scale, than a 'simple' large wind turbine venture, which isn't for this area.

Energy4All is a consultancy service that grew out of the Baywind Co-operative, now nearly 10 years old, and which takes a 9% p.a. return from England's first community owned wind turbines in southern Cumbria. Several others have been developed since, around the UK. Through consultancy, Energy4All passes on the expertise it has developed to new ventures.

So there's a challenge! We await with interest the outcome of John's meetings with his client, *emda*.
